

Stool Sample Collection Instructions

- 1. Place something in the toilet to catch the stool, such as a potty, plastic hat, or an empty plastic food container, or spread clean newspaper or plastic wrap over the rim of the toilet.
- 2. For babies and small children turn disposable diaper inside out or line with plastic wrap to prevent stool sample from being absorbed, scrape stool from surface of plastic wrap.
- 3. Make sure the sample does not touch the inside of the toilet.
- 4. Take care not to urinate in or on the stool sample or in the collection container.
- 5. Use the spoon or spatula that comes with the container to place the sample in a clean screw-top container and screw the lid shut.
- 6. If given multiple collection containers, fill the liquid containing colored top containers first up to the red full line and store at room temperature. Note: this fluid may be poisonous. DO NOT DRINK. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDRED.
- 7. If given a white plan container, this needs to be a fresh stool sample and delivered to the lab within *two (2) hours maximum*.
- 8. Place anything you used to collect the sample in a plastic bag, tie it up and put in the trash.
- 9. Label the container with your name, date of birth, date and time of collection.
- 10. Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and warm running water.
