#### HHH Laboratory Renovation to Begin

Wyatt Brieser, Director of Ancillary Services notes that HHH laboratory renovations will start in September. The updates ensure that the HHH Lab will continue to offer quality service that competes with any hospital in the Midwest.

During that time, the Lab services will relocate to the Northwest Clinic area off the main lobby. There will also be a temporary waiting area in the lobby area.

The Specialty Clinics (including cardiovascular medicine - CVM, urology and the sleep disorder clinic) will continue in that area but will have limited space during this time. We appreciate the flexibility of these providers and their patients.

We hope to conclude renovations and have the lab return to their refurbished state-of-the art space in January 2023. The Specialty Clinics will also return to some improvements and updated décor at that time.

Several people have asked for the recipe for the barbecue served at the Auxiliary's Ice Cream Social. The HHH Nutritional Services staff uses this recipe, attributed to Marilyn McAvoy, to prepare the barbecue.

#### HHH Auxiliary Ice Cream Social Barbeque Recipe (from Marilyn McAvoy)

25# ground beef, browned and drained

4 large onions, chopped

1 bunch celery, chopped

25 oz ketchup

¼ c sugar

42 oz Open Pit Barbeque sauce

24 oz. Sweet Baby Ray's barbeque sauce

20 oz. tomato sauce

Salt & pepper to taste

Combine all ingredients and cook together in a roaster for 4-6 hours. Depending on the size of the bun, it will make approximately 110-140 sandwiches.

Will also freeze well for a quick meal at a later time.
