2020 HHH Auxiliary Contributions Scholarships and Equipment

The Auxiliary provided a **total of \$26,400 in scholarships** awarded to 25 local students studying health careers. There was no CNA program in conjunction with local high schools and Blackhawk College this year.

The *Dinamap* unit pictured to the left is used in Long Term Care and replaces an older unit that was not working properly. It has additional features making it safe, accurate and efficient to use.

The Dinamap is a mobile unit that monitors residents' pulse rate, oxygenation levels, blood pressure and temperature.

It is used up to 36 times daily and records objective measures to identify vital health concerns of the residents.

Dinamap usage during infection surveillance was the reason that we caught one of our first COVID cases and has been a key tool in avoiding future COVID outbreaks.

Message from Mark

As of 2/1/2021, following are some ways COVID has impacted Hammond-Henry over the past 44 weeks:

- 85 COVID inpatients since March 2020 •
- 6 deaths at HHH involving COVID patients •
- 81 HHH healthcare workers (18%) were ill with • COVID
- Highest volume week for testing COVID patients was 2,100 patients in one week
- During a recent week, 389 were tested and only 50 were positive
- The preliminary 7-day statewide positivity rate for cases as a percent of total tests from Jan. 6-12 is 7.3%, and the seven-day test positivity rate is 8.3%
- Current Illinois positivity rate is 5.7%, Henry County is at 8.1% so that is why we have moved to Tier 1
- All HHH employees that wanted COVID vaccine have received their 2nd dose (70% adoption)
- HHH assisted Geneseo School District vaccines (300 1st doses on Jan. 20 and 78% adoption)
- In HHH Long Term Care, 34 of 35 residents and all interested employees received 2nd dose on January 23rd
- HHH has conducted just over 31,000 total COVID19 tests since March 2020, with an overall positive rate of 12.75%

Looking Ahead.....

The Auxiliary is planning an Annual Meeting on Tuesday, April 20. (As per our bylaws, we are required to have the annual meeting in April.) All are invited to attend, however, we may have a limit on the number depending on the COVID restrictions at that time.

This year, in 2021, the annual meeting will be a <u>business meeting only</u> to receive reports and elect officers and appoint board members. There will be no program or lunch at this time. Look for more details in the next Volunteer Voice.

We hope we can gather together later in the summer or fall to celebrate our accomplishments and share our passion for serving others as health care volunteers.
