Hammond-Henry Hospital Health Screenings


Community Health Screenings will <u>not</u> be held this spring. HHH hopes to make this service available again in the fall 2022.

Message from Mark

Mark Kuhn, HHH CEO, shared the following recognitions that Hammond-Henry Hospital has received recently.

HHH Long Term Care Living Center (LTC) has been recognized as a Five-Star facility by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS). This marks a decade of being awarded this high honor. CMS compiles information from regular inspections and data from nearly 800 long-term care facilities in Illinois. Less than 10% of the facilities achieve five-star status each year.

Hammond-Henry was also recognized by Illinois Critical Access Hospital Network (ICAHN) for being in the top 10% of all critical access hospitals in the country for exceptional outpatient quality of care as well as being a high-achieving HCAHPS hospital. Consumer Assessment Hospital of Providers Healthcare and Systems (HCAHPS) is a survey developed to measure a patient's perception of their care.

Becker's Hospital Review also listed Hammond-Henry Hospital in their annual list of hospitals across the country that were rated five stars in patient experience by CMS. Data used was gathered July 2020 - March 2021.

An excellent experience requires collaboration from all our staff. We are committed to ensuring our patients have great experiences at our hospital and we are delighted that our patient surveys reflect this commitment.
