This training is required for all new volunteers. Hospital policies also require current volunteers to attend training every 2 years to stay up-to-date. You will find out about hospital safety, volunteer procedures, and general updates. Plus it is an opportunity to meet new volunteers or those who volunteer in other areas of the hospital.

Women's Health Programs


Maintaining Mobility is the topic of the January 26 Women's Health program to be presented by Wyatt Brieser.

Highlights of this trip include: Mission San José, The Alamo, El Mercado, Paseo del Rio Cruise, Fredericksburg, National Museum of the Pacific War, Choice on Tour, Historic Pearl District. Along the San Antonio River sit five Spanish colonial era Catholic missions. Because of the missions' historic and cultural significance, in 2015 they were named a UNESCO World Heritage site. It is the first site in Texas to receive this designation and one of only twenty-three in all of the US.
